You'll also create and play musical instruments, inspired by cultures around the world. Our program goes beyond verbal communication, fostering connection through games and exercises that intertwine social, musical, cultural and ecological contexts.

During this intensive journey, participants will explore the intricate connections between landscapes, materials, music-making, natural sources, physics, crafts, and art. Our interdisciplinary approach aims to build bridges between individuals, languages, cultures and songs. The camp offers unique opportunity to find and create, alone and together, inspiring environments, which may reshape perceptions of the world.

Highlights of the Camp Include

- **Finnish-Karelian Wind Instruments:** Learn the art of building and playing traditional wind instruments with Minna.
- **Playing with Stones, Shells, Sticks and Trunks:** Sensing nature is a beautiful pathway, where harmonic music can be born. With Hannes, ecological and musical approach offer holistic experiences of connection.
- **"Sunrise Yoga" Sessions:** Start your day with Frauke; yoga brings balance to body and mind through intensive breathing and singing.

No special skills are needed. Collectively organized camp is open to teachers, educators, social workers, ecologists, scientists, musicians, therapists, and anyone interested in the topic. Participants must be at least 16 years old. Those with younger children should care for them or form a group with shared responsibility.

Camp Details

- **Date** July 5th–10th. The day before is for arrival, and the day after is for departure or for a guided walk. Organizers welcome assistance.
- **Location** Länsitalo Homestead, Koski TL, Finland
